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## Regulatory Training Written Courses



**Alzheimer's Train-the-Trainer** workbook: *Dementia Training for the Special Care of Nursing Home Residents* developed by Menorah Manor, St. Petersburg, Florida. The training course has been approved by the Florida Department of Elder Affairs (DoEA) as meeting the nursing home administrators requirements for training employees about Alzheimer's disease and related disorders and is relevant to anyone providing housing or long-term care services to people with Dementia or Alzheimer's. This curriculum is valid until 4/30/2011.

### **Defensive Documentation for CNAs (written course) (In-service training one contact hour)**

What Certified Nursing Assistants need to know about defensive and medical record documentation and the legalities of charting. This course provides the following information:

- An Understanding of Medical Record Documentation
- How to Distinguish Different Charting Formats
- Meeting the Challenges of Documentation from a CNA's Perspective
- How to Make Sure Your Documentation is Satisfactory
- Tips for Defensive Documentation — “Legally Speaking”

### **Detection & Prevention of Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation Written Course (six contact hours)**

This comprehensive course will take you through the eight steps in developing a proactive program, the seven components for prevention and detection, as well as the history, definitions, signs and symptoms of abuse, neglect, and exploitation. Participants will engage in activities and exercises associated with detection and prevention of abuse and neglect. **Target Audience:** LPNs, RNs, Nursing Home Administrators, Risk Managers.

### **LPN Leadership and Supervision Written Course (30 contact hours)**

This course has been developed for LPNs to obtain 30 contact hours, which is required by the Department of Health, Board of Nursing for **ALL** LPNs in a supervising role in Nursing Homes. **The four modules include:** Understanding Florida Nursing Law, Communication Dynamics, Foundations of Supervisory Skills, and Advanced Supervisory Skills.

**Target Audience:** LPNs.

## Regulatory Training Media Series

Don't miss this opportunity to purchase a video training series that may be used in a classroom setting or as a self-study program to fulfill statutorily-mandated training requirements. Tapes can be ordered individually or as a series. Each video tape includes learning objectives, suggested study handouts for students, a post-test and instructor's answer key (for non-licensed professionals), a sample certificate of completion for unlicensed staff and a separate test for licensed staff. Educational programs are approved by the Florida Board of Nursing, the Florida Board of Nursing Home Administrators, and Florida Board of Clinical Social Work.



### **Domestic Violence: Dynamics and Interventions (two contact hour)**

This course meets the legal requirement in s.455.597, F.S., that licensed nurses, physicians, and other health care professionals complete a one-hour course on domestic violence as a condition of licensure and license renewal. The course includes an overview of training mandated by law; Florida domestic violence law, rule, and model protocol; dynamics and interventions of domestic violence.

**Target Audience:** LPNs, RNs, and Social Workers.

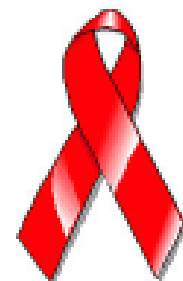
**Domestic Violence and Human Trafficking (two contact hour)** This course features a well-known and renowned presenter, Robin H. Thompson, M.A., J.D., of Robin H. Thompson and Associates. Her work includes domestic and sexual violence law and policy analysis, Violence Against Women Act implementation, adult domestic violence fatality reviews, workplace violence law and policy, health care issues and human trafficking. Florida law requires nurses, LPNs, and social workers to complete a course on domestic violence once every third renewal and before the first licensure renewal. In addition, certified nursing assistants must receive domestic violence training once every two years.

**Target Audience:** Nursing Home Administrators, Nurses, and Social Workers.

### **The Facts about HIV/AIDS (one contact hour)**

This course meets the one hour requirement and includes a in-depth overview of training mandated by law (456.033, F.S.); current statistics and demographics; mode and prevention of transmissions; infection control; treatment of HIV/AIDS and the current Florida law.

**Target Audience:** Entire Staff.



### **Resident Abuse Prevention Program (RAPP) (two contact hours)**

This four-tape video course, written and developed by ACTS, Inc., will provide your entire staff with resident abuse training education, a test and two hours of continuing education credits. This course provides an interactive teaching approach to the prevention and detection of resident abuse. After watching these videos you staff will be able to: 1) Identify educational challenges in long-term care; 2) Discuss history of RAPP; 3) Describe methodology, benefits, and challenges of RAPP; and 4) Identify the components of abuse through the use of video-based scenarios.

**Target Audience:** Entire Staff.

### **Patient Safety: Preventing Medical Risks In Long-term Health Care Settings (two contact hours)**

FAHSA's new patient safety training program is designed for long-term care staff education by focusing on recognizing system errors. It provides excellent recommendations to identify and reduce potential medical errors. The course provides numerous ways to prevent error-prone situations and improve patient outcomes. Topics cover include: medication safety systems, culture of safety and employee practices.

The course was developed in response to Section 456.013 (7), F.S. requiring Florida health care professionals to take a two hour medical course for licensure renewal. This program will meet the two hour requirement for renewal. Our course includes a post-test, which once completed and passed, provides two hour continuing education credits.

**Target Audience:** LPNs, RNs, Nursing Home Administrators, Risk Mangers, and Social Workers.
